Frequently Asked Questions

- Q** Why would a merchant want to replace a reliable, secure T7 Series Hypercom terminal with a new T7Plus ?
- A** The T7Plus terminal is faster and has valuable new features. This translates into a greater return on investment.
- Q** Does the T7Plus provide any graphic printing capabilities ?
- A** Yes, the T7Plus prints merchant logos directly on standard thermal receipt paper. This enhances customer awareness and recognition.
- Q** What features of the T7Plus are improved over the current T7 Series products ?
- A** Faster, quieter printer eliminates paper jams; receipts are printed in half the time of previous generation printers; bigger paper holder makes for fewer paper changes; optional four-line display is easier to read. Both customers and cashiers will appreciate the quick, quiet operation.
- Q** Will the T7Plus take up more counter-space than the T7 terminals ?
- A** No, the T7Plus has a smaller footprint than the T7P, the T7PF and the T7PG.
- Q** Is the T7 Series software compatible with T7Plus software ?
- A** Yes, T7Plus software is fully compatible with T7 Series software.
- Q** Does the T7Plus have an integrated smart card reader ?
- A** Yes, the integrated smart card reader is an option based on ISO 7816 standards and is EMV compliant.
- Q** Will T7Plus paper rolls have to be changed more often than T7 Series paper rolls ?
- A** No, paper rolls used in the T7Plus are up to 80mm in diameter (3.15 inches), providing more receipts and reports between paper changes.
- Q** Does the T7Plus have an impact-type printer ?
- A** No, thermal printing has become the industry standard of choice and the T7Plus SureLoad® printer is state-of-the-art.
- Q** Can the T7Plus accept an external PIN pad ?
- A** Yes, the peripheral port is compatible with all Hypercom PIN pads. Optionally, the T7Plus also is available with an internal PIN pad, eliminating the need for peripheral devices.
- Q** How long will it take to retrain my cashiers to use the T7Plus ?
- A** Virtually not time at all, since most features are exactly the same as the T7 Series terminals.
